Maria Glyka (Grecia, 1973) es uno de los personajes dinámicos del circuito artístico de su país. Desde el 2003, es miembro del colectivo PLATFORMES. Con base en Atenas, este colectivo formado por músicos, artistas plásticos, y profesionales del cine, trabajan contra la censura del arte en su país. En el 2006, obtiene su MFA en pintura, en la Slade School of Art, Londres. Numerosos galardones incluyen el *Celeste Prize*, The Well, Londres 2006 y la *Germine Muse* por "Mejor artista en museos europeos", en 2005. ha participado en numerosas exposiciones internacionales incluyendo la *Jerwood Contemporary Painters* en Jerwood Space, Londres, 2007.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

Maria Glyka (1973, Greece) is one of the most dynamic young artists in Greece. She has been a member of PLATFORMES since 2003, a collective of arts professionals ranking from musicians to film makers and visual artists, based in Athens who lobby against censorship of the arts in their country. Having completed her MFA painting at the Slade School of Art (London), Glyka has won numerous awards including the *Germine Muse* 2005 award for "Young artist in European Museums", and the *Celeste Prize*, The Well, London in 2006. She has participated in group shows internationally, including the *Jerwood Contemporary Painters* at Jerwood Space, London, in 2007.
